

How to get to the Radcliffe Learning Centre in the Cathedral

1. If entering the cathedral from the main West Doors:

Proceed along the entry aisle, just past the Welcome Desk area, and then turn right at the bridge across the Cathedral.

Walk across the full width of the Cathedral and then under the entrance arch where the red telephone box is situated.

Take the stairs on the right up to the first floor – you are at the Radcliffe Learning Centre.

If you have difficulty negotiating stairs, there is an unmanned lift available next to the red telephone box. This is normally watched over by the Tower attendant at this level, who should arrange access for you. You need to exit at Floor 1.

2. If entering the Cathedral via the Western Rooms entrance:

Proceed through the main Western Room doors, through the reception areas and the following 2 sets of double doors.

On your immediate left after the second set of doors, take the stairs up 2 floors, past the telephone box on the next floor and you will arrive at the Radcliffe Learning Centre.

If you have difficulty negotiating stairs, on your immediate right opposite the stairs after the double doors, there is an unmanned lift available. Call the lift, and then select Floor 1. You are at the Radcliffe Learning Centre.

If the lift is 'switched off' at that level, seek assistance from a member of Cathedral staff, who will gladly arrange lift access for you.

3. Totally Lost???
